This letter is in response to your December 6, 1999, letter to Mr. Clyde Brill concerning the shale pit at the intersection of Cacapon River Road and Hooks Mill Road in Hampshire County.


The Division of Highways has for several years used the material, at no cost from this pit, for stabilization of roads in the area and continues to do so.

Upon discontinuing the removal of material, we will dress the slope to as near a 1:1 as possible, place available top soil on it, and seed and mulch the area.
